

What is your ZIP/Postal Code?






Number of respondents




How do you travel on 600/700 North?

"Yes, it is a road I often will use, but it is not the most comfortable due to the speed of cars and amount of space for cars only."



Do you ever avoid 600/700 North? Why?


"I generally **can't** because my family lives on the other side, and the freeway cuts off any other options. But I do think **it's too wide**, and as a bike commuter **I hate having to cross it**. I would **avoid it as it is if I could**."

What are the biggest issues with 600/700 North? (Other please specify)



"Too many **homeless** loitering and littering."





Click on the map where you think the biggest problem is.














What is the "biggest problem" at the point you selected on the map?



"I'm the principal at Backman Elementary.
We have a metal fence between our school's parking lot and 600/700 North that has been run into and partially destroyed at that curvature in the road three times just this past school year. **People tend to go too fast** in that section."

"This area is extremely **unsafe** for **pedestrians** and **cyclists** because of **high car speeds** and drivers that frequently run lights."



What is the "biggest problem" at the point you selected on the map?


"Heading east towards downtown, I'm **constantly worried** about getting **t-boned** from cars travel through both the 900 and 1000 intersections."

"The biggest problem is not just a single point on a map. I appreciate the opportunity to contribute some thoughts, but the 700/600 N street is historically plagued with **excessive high-speed travel**."

"The **transition from freeway traffic to a residential** neighborhood is **abrupt**. Improvements made 5-6 years ago have helped but it is still an area where **cars and people do not mix** well."

What do you like about 600/700 North that should stay the same?


I would like to see this street completely transformed. But, I do have concerns that it may encourage more through traffic on residential streets adjacent to this road..."

"Set back sidewalk"




What improvements would you like to see on 600/700 North?

"Complete separation from cars. I don't trust people coming off I-15 to drive like they're in a neighborhood."

"A bike lane separated from the road."

"Nothing! The Salt Lake staff are SO out of touch with the **predominant mode of travel** for the vast majority of **working class folks**."


"Shade, smoother roads, better lights."

"I think the biggest problem is **speeding cars**...The **bus stops could use upgrades**, plus the drainage and curbs around those stops. It can be really difficult getting onto a bus from some of the stops.


"Please do not make this a 1 lane road, or reduce speeds, it will just push more traffic into the neighborhood streets."

"The biggest and most critical improvements in my opinion that could be made to this street are to **reduce speeds of drivers**, reduce or eliminate heavy duty truck traffic, and **create more safe crossings for cyclists and pedestrians...**While protected bike lanes would be a "nice to have" they aren't a priority for me as I am more likely to ride on slower speed residential streets nearby."



What is your age




What is your household income level?


